The Principality of Hutt River is situated 595 km north of Perth, Western Australia and is about 75 square km in area, consisting of some 18,500 acres of undulating farmland, well covered in places with a wealth of shrubs and glorious wildflowers.

Hutt River is an Independent Sovereign State having seceded from Australia on the Twenty First Day of April 1970 and is comparable in size to Hong Kong (not the New Territories).

The town site of Nain has been developed with a number of buildings designed to provide facilities for the visitors who visit in their thousands each year. Facilities include: The Administration Building, containing Government Offices and the Royal Hutt River Post Office. The Chapel of Nain, a charming Inter-Denominational Chapel. The arcade which houses the Memorabilia Department and Historical Society displays. The Sovereigns Reception building and Princess Shirley's Sacred Educational Shrine, the Gateway to Natures Spirit World, which also houses the 'Stone of Light'.
