

Formal Proclamation of the Government of the Native American Tribal Republic of Timucua.

Be it known by all men who hear these greetings, The Government of the Native American Tribal Republic of Timucua in full combined session of the Legislative Council of Tribal Chieftains, Executive Council of Tribal Chieftains and Judicial Council of Tribal Chieftains hereby issues the following proclamation.

Through this proclamation issued this 29th Day of August in The Year of our Lord 2009, the Government hereby proclaims that the fourth week of every August from henceforth shall be declared *The Week of Friendship with the Principality of Hutt River* celebrating the friendship between the people of Timucua and the people of the Principality of Hutt River.

This week shall be observed as a time of national holiday and celebration and well wishing in honor of the Birthday of His Royal Highness, Prince Leonard of Hutt River.

The day when the 27th of August shall fall on this week from henceforth shall be declared **Prince Leonard Day** to celebrate His Royal Highness's Birthday and in honor of the great inspiration that Prince Leonard has been and continues to be to our people in our journey towards our continued independence and excellence.

Also this is declared in honor of the great assistance that has been informally given by various citizens of the Principality of Hutt River to our people over the years of our independence.

Signed in Full Session of the Government, this 29th Day of August in The Year of our Lord 2009.
